The Lunar Seventh Month starts on 3 Aug 2016. The Chinese believes that this important festival in the Chinese calendar, also known as the Hungry Ghost Festival (盂兰节), is when spirits roam the earth. Chinese make offerings to their ancestors, and at the same time make efforts to appease the spirits with offerings, prayers and traditional shows and performances.
