During *Qing Ming* Festival, one carries out the cleaning of tombs of and paying of respect to one's ancestors or loved ones who have passed on.

Thian Hock Keng continues to preserve this tradition by making offerings and cleaning the niches of more than 3000 unknown remains during the festival. The remains were exhumed from cemeteries managed by the Huay Kuan in the past.


